GENERAL INFORMATION

Theme

- ◆ The theme for the new collection is "Through my eyes"
- ◆ Young artists are free to paint/draw whatever they like but must include a title and story for the picture

Material

- ◆ Gallery Amichi will supply each school with *10 sheets of special hand-made art paper*, produced by the *Euraba Aboriginal Paper Company* (see enclosed information)
- ◆ Work for the new collection **must be submitted** on this paper
- ◆ Artists are free to use pencil, coloured pencils, paints, crayons etc
- ◆ Artist's name and title of work should be clearly written on the *BACK* of the artwork
- ◆ Please **do not** staple/pin/paste anything to the artwork

Requirements

- ◆ **Enclosed ID** sheet for each *artist* to be completed. Please include:
 - ✚ **Title** of the picture
 - ✚ 2-6 sentence **story/description** of the work
 - ✚ **Artist's comment** on participation in the event
- ◆ **Permission slip** for each artist to be completed *and* signed by parent/care/school principal (where relevant)
- ◆ **Enclosed ID** sheet for your school/community. Please include brief school/community *profile* and *comment* on participation in the project
- ◆ **Cut-off dates** are confirmed and cannot be extended. However, please return the art and required documents to Gallery Amichi in Sydney *as soon as possible*
- ◆ **Photos** (students with their work and photos of the school) will be greatly appreciated. They would be used for exhibition and related purposes only.
- ◆ There is *no problem with languages other than English* being used. In fact, this will be great, **BUT** an English *translation will also be* necessary. Please contact us if language is an issue.
